

Dawn Alisha Lott (b. 1965)

Lott is a full professor of mathematics and the Director of the Honors Program at Delaware State University, having previously worked at New Jersey Institute of Technology. Her research is in numerical partial differential equations applied to solid mechanics, fluid mechanics, and biomechanics. She has supervised one woman's doctorate. Lott has been honored by Delaware State for excellence in service and advising, and she has been an AMS/MAA Falconer lecturer (2011). She was a "Mathematically

Gifted and Black" Black History Month Honoree (2019), and she was recently named an AWM Fellow (2021). Lott has been living with Myasthenia Gravis since the age of 13.
