



Fan Chung (b. 1949)

Chung is from Taiwan and did her graduate work in the US. She worked at Bell Labs and Bellcore for twenty years before moving to the University of California, San Diego. Her research is in graph theory and combinatorics, where she has collaborated with over 120 mathematicians and published 300 papers. Chung has served as editor-in-chief and on the editorial board for many

journals. She was an invited speaker at the International Congress of Mathematicians (1994) and was the AWM Noether lecturer (2009). Chung received the MAA's Allendoerfer Award (1990) and Euler Medal (2017). She is a fellow of AAAS (2002), AMS (2013), and SIAM (2015).
