



# Helena Nussenzveig

(b. 1963)

Nussenzveig is a Brazilian mathematician who did graduate work in the US, spent two decades at the University of Campinas in São Paulo, and is now full professor at the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro where she was head of the mathematics department (2014–2016). She is known for her contributions to partial differential equations, particularly fluid dynamics. Nussenzveig was awarded

the National Order of Scientific Merit in Brazil (2010). She is Fellow of SIAM (2016) and a Fellow of the AMS (2020). Nussenzveig was an invited speaker at the International Congress of Mathematicians (2018), the same year she was elected to the Brazilian Academy of Sciences.
