

Ling Long (b. 1974)

Long is from China and went to graduate school in the US, where both of her doctoral advisors were women. She is now full professor at Louisiana State University, having previously taught for a decade at lowa State. Her interests are in modular forms, Galois representations, and hypergeometric functions. Long has supervised two PhD students and mentored numerous female students, postdocs,

and young faculty members. She was a Clay Mathematics Institute Liftoff Fellow (2002), and was awarded the Ruth I. Michler Memorial Prize (2012). She is on the steering committee of Women in Number Theory (WIN), an organization that has created a research community and mentoring network.
