

Olga Tsuberbiller (1885–1975)

Olga Tsuberbiller was a professor at Moscow State University of Fine Chemical Technology for four decades. She published the standard Soviet textbook *Problems and Exercises in Analytic Geometry* (1927) that is still in use today in Russian high schools and technical institutions. Earlier, while teaching at the Bestuzhev Courses—then the most prominent women's higher education institution in Russia—she organized a mathematics library, tutored and advised undergraduate

and graduate students, and worked to popularize the study of mathematics. Tsuberbiller was named one of the Honored Scientists of the Russian Soviet Federative Socialist Republic (1955). She was partnered with opera singer Concordia Antarova for more than 20 years.
