Harris is from Mexico and grew up there and in Wisconsin. She was initially unable to enroll at a four-year college because of her immigration status. Harris now teaches at Williams College, having previously been at the US Military Academy. She works in algebraic combinatorics and in representation theory. Harris has published more than 40 research papers in less than 10

years. In 2016, she co-founded the *Lathisms* website. In 2020, she began co-hosting *Mathematically Uncensored* podcast as part of the Center for Minorities in the Mathematical Sciences. Harris won an MAA Alder Award (2019) and is one of the three inaugural 2020 Karen EDGE Fellows.
