

Rosa Maria Miró-Roig (b. 1960)

Miró-Roig is full professor at the University of Barcelona, in her hometown. Her work focuses on algebraic geometry and commutative algebra. Miró-Roig has co-edited or co-authored numerous research volumes, including *Projective Varieties with Unexpected Properties* (2004), and *On the Shape of a*

Pure O-sequence (2012). Her monograph Determinantal Ideals (2007) earned her the Premi Ferran Sunyer i Balaguer from the Institut d'Estudis Catalans. Miró-Roig has served as Principal Investigator on projects funded by five Spanish agencies. She is Editor in Chief of Collectanea Mathematica, an internationally recognized journal and the oldest mathematics journal in Spain. She has supervised 8 doctoral students, of whom 5 were women.

This poster is part of the EvenQuads project, which combines innovative mathematical card games with learning about amazing women mathematicians. The project celebrates the 50th anniversary of the Association for Women in Mathematics.
