

## Rosemary Guzman (b. late 1900s)

Guzman is Mexican-American and a Teaching Assistant Professor at University of Illinois the (in Urbana-Champaign). She served two terms as assistant director of the Illinois Geometry Lab. She was also an NSF Alliance postdoctoral fellow at the University of Iowa and an AAUW American postdoctoral fellow at the University of Chicago. Guzman works in hyperbolic 3-manifolds and geometric group

theory. Guzman has co-organized three conference sessions focusing on inclusion of traditionally underrepresented groups in mathematics. She has been an invited speaker in the IPAM Latinos in the Mathematical Sciences Conference, and was featured in the Notices of the AMS during Women's History Month in 2018.
