Toro, from Colombia, did her graduate work in the US. Her career has been at the University of Washington, in Seattle, where she is the Craig McKibben & Sarah Merner Professor. She works in geometric measure theory, and has supervised 7 PhD students, 2 of them women. Toro has served on many editorial boards. She spoke at the International Congress of Mathematicians (2010). She has held Radcliffe Institute, Sloan, Guggenheim, and Simons Fellowships, is a fellow

of the AMS (2016), and won the Blackwell-Tapia Prize (2020). Toro is a member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences (2020), and the Academia Colombiana de Ciencias Exactas, Físicas y Naturales (2020).
