Ami Radunskaya earned her PhD from Stanford University (1992). She is currently Professor of Mathematics at Pomona College and on the Extended Graduate Faculty of Claremont Graduate University. She was a postdoc at Rice University. Radunskaya works in dynamical systems and non-linear models of biological systems. She has advised multiple PhD students and over 150 undergraduate theses. Radunskaya has been a cellist with the Oakland Symphony Orchestra and is a published composer.

Radunskaya was AWM President (2017–2019). She is currently the

Enhancing Diversity in Graduate Education (EDGE) Foundation president. Radunskaya earned the AAAS Mentor Award (2017). She is a Fellow of the AMS (2017) and the AWM (2021).
