



Chuu-Lian Terng (b. 1949)

Chuu-Lian Terng received her PhD from Brandeis University in 1976. She spent most of her career at Northeastern University and the University of California at Irvine. Terng is the author of over 60 research papers in submanifold geometry and integrable PDEs. Her co-authored book *Critical Point Theory and Submanifold Geometry*

had 38 editions between 1987 and 2006 and was published in three languages. She has been active in the AWM throughout her career and served as AWM president (1995–1997). Terng has been on several editorial boards, including for the *Proceedings of the AMS*. Her numerous recognitions include a Sloan Fellowship (1980), a Humboldt Senior Scientist Award (1996), and an invited ICM talk (2006).
