

Hannah Fry (b. 1984)

Hannah Fry received a PhD in fluid dynamics from the Department of Mathematics at University College London (2011) and is currently a professor in the Mathematics of Cities at UCL's Centre for Advanced Spatial Analysis. Fry is a science presenter, public speaker, and best-selling author. Her TEDx talk "The Mathematics of Love" has attracted over 5.2 million views. Fry

has received many awards, including the UCL Provost's Public Engager of the Year award (2013), the Christopher Zeeman Medal from the Institute of Mathematics and its Applications and the London Mathematical Society (2018), and the 2020 Asimov Prize, from the Gran Sasso Science Institute for her book *Hello World*.
