Joan Hutchinson earned her PhD from the University of Pennsylvania in 1973. Having served on the faculty at Smith College (1976–1990) and Macalester College (1990–2011), she is now Professor Emerita at Macalester. Hutchinson has published more than 70 research articles on graph theory and her work has been supported by grants from the National Science Foundation. She received an MAA Carl B. Allendoerfer Award (1994) for an expository article on generalizations of the Four Color Theorem

and the MAA Deborah and Franklin Tepper Haimo Award (1999) for excellence in teaching. Hutchinson has been active with the MAA, the SIAM Discrete Math Activity Group, and the Association for Women in Mathematics (AWM).
