

## Nancy Geller (b. 1944)

Nancy Geller earned her PhD from Case Western Reserve University (1972) and was on the faculty at institutions including the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania (1972–1978) and Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center (1979–1990). Since 1990 she has di-

rected the Office of Biostatistics Research of the National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute. Geller has co-authored several hundred scientific papers, providing collaboration in studies of heart, lung, and blood diseases, and has also published on the design of clinical trials. She was named a Fellow of the American Statistical Association (2003) and won the Norwood Award for Outstanding Achievement by a Woman in the Statistical Sciences (2009).
