

## Peregrina Quintela Estévez (b. 1960)

Peregrina Quintela Estévez holds two doctorates in mathematics, from Universidad Autónoma de Madrid (1986) and Université Pierre et Marie Curie in Paris (1988). She works in applied and industrial mathematics at Universidade de Santiago de Compostela in Galicia, Spain and is especially interested in technology transfer and mathematical modeling. Besides amassing a record including more than 70 publications, Quintela has been

extremely active in fostering networks and partnerships between academia, industry, and government. Organizations she has led include the Spanish Network for Mathematics and Industry, ITMATI, EU-MATHS-IN, and PET MSO-ED. In 2016, Quintela received the María Josefa Wonenburger Planells Prize from the Government of Galicia.
