

## Raegan J. Higgins (b. 1980)

Higgins earned her PhD in mathematics from University of Nebraska-Lincoln (2008). She is currently Associate Professor of Mathematics and Assistant Vice Provost for Faculty Success at Texas Tech University, where her research is in mathematical biology. She has worked throughout her career to improve the training of pre-service teachers and to increase the participation of women and people of color in

STEM. She is also co-director of the EDGE Program (2017–) and a co-founder of the *Mathematically Gifted & Black* website. She received AWM's Service Award in 2020 and its Gweneth Humphreys Award in 2021. Her outreach activities have been funded by the NSF Bridges Across Texas Louis Stokes Alliances for Minority Participation grant (2017–2026).
