She is currently a staff data scientist at Waymo, an autonomous driving technology company. Espinosa is interested in causal inference, design and analysis of experiments, and Bayesian modeling. Espinosa's undergraduate thesis at Instituto Tecnológico Autónomo de México (ITAM) won the Premio de

Investigación Ex-ITAM in 2007. She graduated with a Mención Honorífica from ITAM, received a Goldman Sachs Global Leaders Award, and at Harvard won a Derek C. Bok Award for Excellence in Graduate Student Teaching of Undergraduates in 2012.
