

Veena Mendiratta (b. 1948)

Veena Mendiratta received her BTech in engineering from the Indian Institute of Technology (New Delhi) in 1970, and then earned her PhD from Northwestern University in Operations Research in 1981. She worked for Bell Labs for more than 35 years doing research on network reliability and telecom data analytics. Mendiratta is currently an Adjunct Professor at Northwestern. She is an author on more than 65 research papers and

holds 5 US patents. Mendiratta has done outreach through the Society for Industrial and Applied Mathematics as part of their Visiting Lecturer Program and did project-based exchanges while part of the Fulbright Specialist Program in India (2012) and Norway (2015).
