## Tips for addressing expectations when engaging in MURAL

## Memorandum of research expectations

Try to address these early and upfront.

- 1. Talk about meaningful collaboration.
- 2. Talk about employee responsibility early.
- 3. Talk about being respectful.
- 4. Does your college have a code of conduct?
- 5. Show evidence that diverse, collaborative teams are more prolific.
- 6. Co-construct student expectations and penalties.
- 7. Lead to each student coming up with a contract for behavior and consequences.

## Authorship when working with students

- 1. Talk about authorship early
- 2. Have written guidelines
- 3. When a target journal has been identified and you are polishing the work, reach out to former students. Be clear about the criteria for authorship and a date by which you need to know about their participation.
