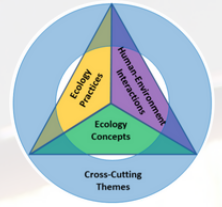




# TRANSFORMING ECOLOGY EDUCATION TO 4D

- Catalyze the production of exemplar curricular materials and tools that are aligned to the Four-Dimensional Ecology education (4DEE) framework.
- Foster inclusive practices for diverse student populations to engage in ecology both online and on-campus.
- Leverage connections to existing networks relevant to ecology education that will accelerate the adoption of the 4DEE framework.
